JR EAST PASS (TOHOKU AREA)

• Eligibility

Valid from 1st April 2016

The JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) is available exclusively for visitors from abroad who enter Japan under the entry status of "Temporary Visitor". Both of the below two conditions must be met for purchase and use

- The pass user must have a passport issued by a country other than Japan.
 (日本国籍のお客様は使用できません。)
- The pass user must enter Japan as a temporary visitor and have "Temporary Visitor" stamped in their passport as shown at right.
- The status of temporary visitor is established in Japanese immigration law and permits stays in the country of up to 90 days for purposes such as sightseeing. Visitors desiring to enter Japan for sightseeing will receive a stamp, as shown at right, saying "Temporary Visitor" in their passport by the immigration officer

Valid Train Routes

Unlimited travel on local, limited express and express trains including bullet trains on the following rail company lines:

- JR East Lines (including BRT*)
- Izu Kyuko Line
- Aoimori Railway
- Iwate Galaxy Railway (IGR)
- Tokyo Monorail
- Sendai Airport Transit
- The following limited express trains that directly run between the JR East lines and Tobu Railway lines: the Nikko, the SPACIA Nikko, the Kinugawa, and the SPACIA Kinugawa. The pass can be used for travel on local and rapid trains between Shimo-imaichi and Tobu-nikko/Kinugawa-onsen on Tobu Railway Lines. Between Kurihashi and Shimo-imaichi Stations, the pass may be used only on limited express trains as above, that connect directly with Tobu Railway Lines.**

Notes:

- * Bus rapid transit.
- **The JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) may be used for Tobu Railway Lines as long as either the departing or destination station is on a JR line.
- The JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) is not valid for the Tokaido Shinkansen as that is operated by a different rail company.
- GALA Yuzawa Station is in operation only in winter and spring.
- Special operating intervals and trains may be in service to meet the needs in the aftermath of the 2011 Tohoku earthquake and tsunami.
- The JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) is not valid for JR buses.

Train Accommodations

The JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) is valid on ordinary cars.

To ride on Green Cars, GranClass, individual compartments, Liners or sleeper cars, an additional purchase is required, such as a limited express or sleeper ticket.

•How to purchase

Exchange Orders (e-ticket) can be purchased in advance online or from overseas travel agents.



*When exchanging, it is necessary to present your passport. Passport copies cannot be accepted

• How to reserve a designated seat

Making a Reservation at a Station

Visit a JR Ticket Office (Midori-no-madoguchi) or Travel Service Center (View Plaza), located in most major JR East stations, and present your JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) to reserve a seat.

Making an Online Reservation

Some JR East Shinkansen and limited express seats can be reserved online.

Changes

The starting date of the JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) may not be changed

Refunds

Refunds are made for Exchange Orders (e-ticket) within one year of issuance if not redeemed. . A fee may be charged by the seller. A fee may apply for refunds. The amount of the fee depends on the seller.

• Other

Lost Exchange Orders (e-ticket) and JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) will not be reissued

The JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) is non-transferrable.

Only the person whose name is on the pass may use it.

Travelers must carry their passport when using the JR EAST PASS (Tohoku area) as they may be asked to present it for identification purposes
